This department has about 75 computers, necessary software and hardware. Along with this, the department has its own library which has around 2300 books. Internet facility is available on all computers. Two

newspapers (Punjabi Tribune and The Tribune) are coming to the department every month to increase the knowledge of the students. A seminar on "Career and Motivation of Self" was organized by this department on 19-11-2018 in which Dr. Harpreet Singh, Principal of Guru Nanak Dev Engineering College, Ludhiana participated as a resource person. On 19-03-19 on the topic "Computerization of Punjabi language" Dr. C.P. Kamboj, Assistant Professor, Punjabi Computer Support Center, Punjabi University Patiala delivered a lecture and provided information about various software developed in Punjabi language and Punjabi fonts. On 23-03-19, a workshop on "Fabric Printing" was conducted in which Prof. Anchala from Akal Degree College for Women Sangrur gave information about printing to the students.
