

Helps. They also help in assessing the impact of organizational performance and its management on gender equality within the organization. Gender audits establish a baseline against which progress can be measured over time, identify significant gender gaps and challenges, and make recommendations on how they can be addressed through improvements and innovations are done.

Objective

The purpose of the audit is to ensure that:

- The specific objective of the audit is to evaluate the adequacy of the management control framework as well as the degree of compliance with the rules, policies and standards applicable to girls by the departments.
