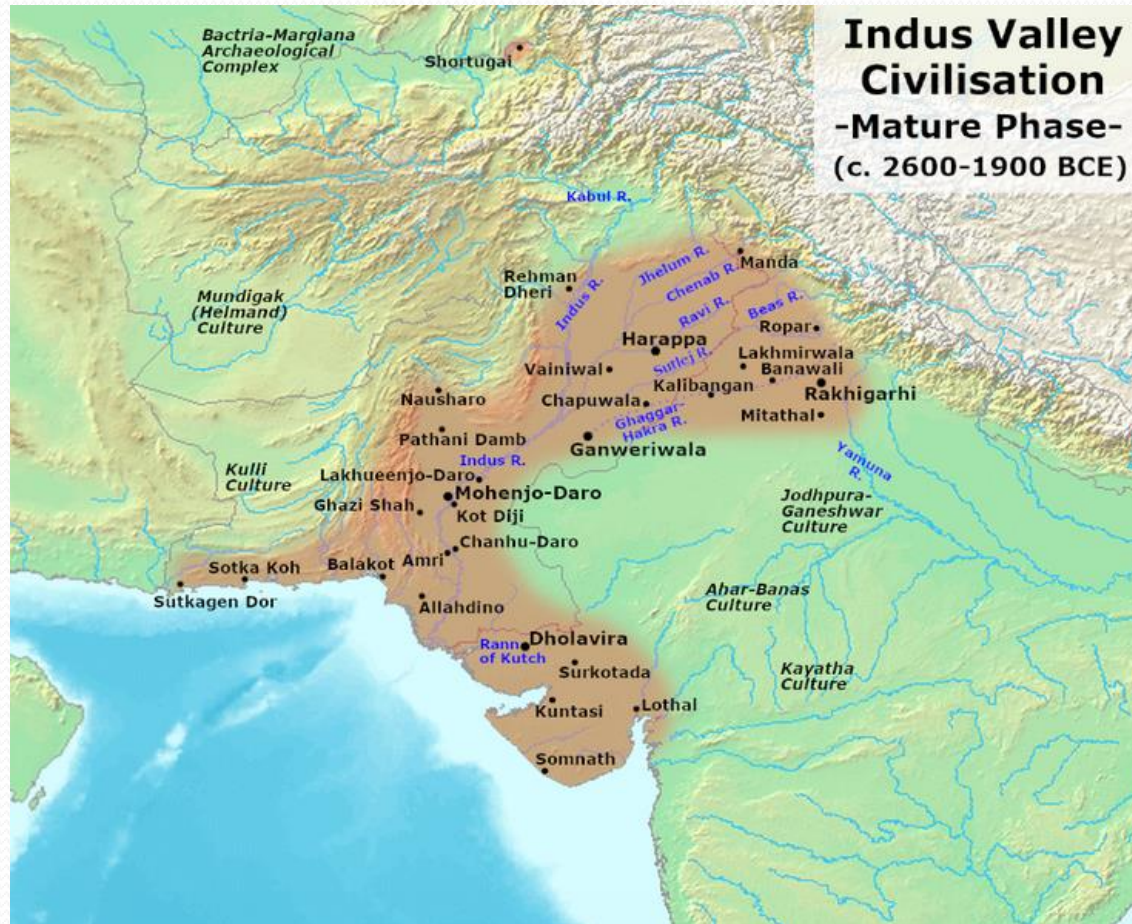

MAP OF INDUS VALLEY



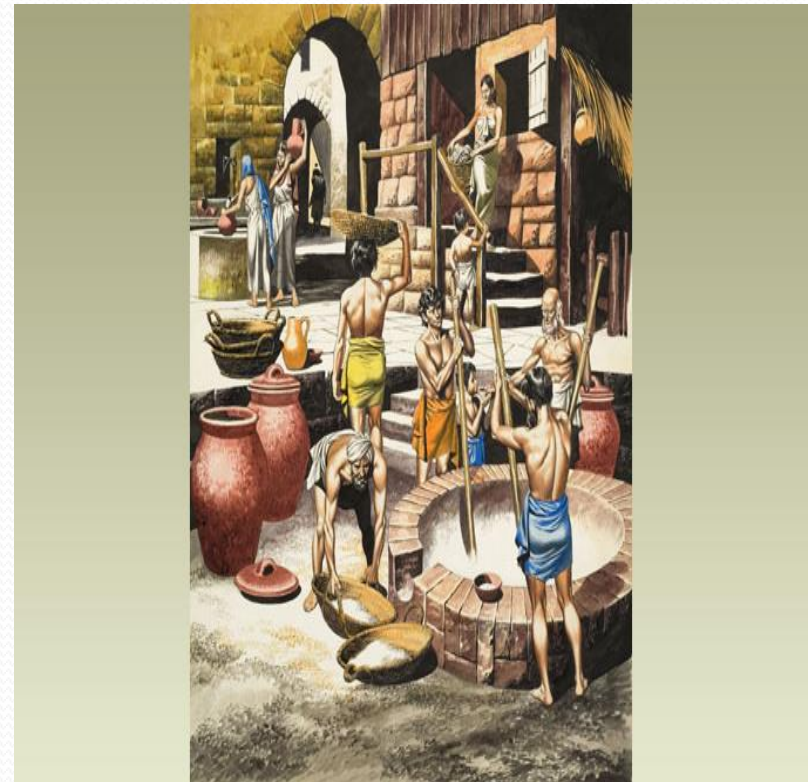

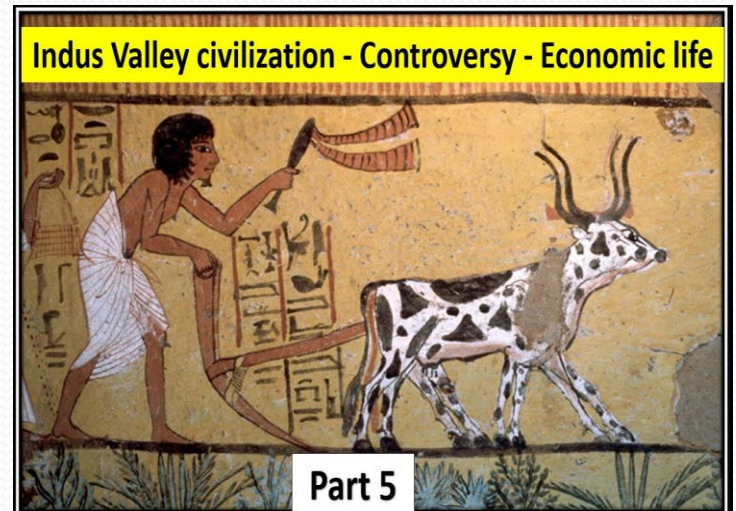
